Deuteronomy 1:33: Our Lord searched out yet another place where Molinar Mission should camp-out and teach with Cyprian Antwi Awuah from Ghana. After teaching in Malelane, He led them on their journey into Kruger Game Reserve, and then to teach more in KaNyamazane.



Cyprian studied under the ministry of R B Thieme Jr. Over the years, he printed all the Colonel's *e-books*, bound them into a single volume that stands about ten inches high! He also printed volumes of Dr Chafer's Systematic Theology. Cyprian started the ***Bold Grace Bible Institute*** in Ghana, where he teaches other reliable teachers who will be qualified to teach others (2 Tim 2:2). He also teaches in Togo, Nigeria, Benin, and Ivory Coast.

Sounds good? Not one bit! Cyprian tackled this charismatic trend that has spread throughout Africa. He exposed it as false & non-Biblical. Nothing more than *'magical incantations'* using words to manipulate events. He had the groups in tears of laughter as he explained how he was deceived into speaking in tongues!

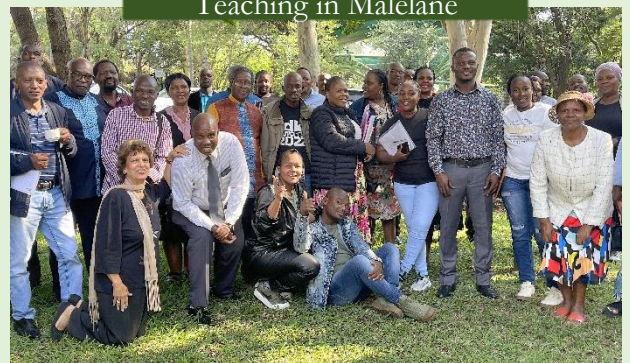
